He attained his **Bachelor of Horticultural Science in 1994**, followed by a **Master of Science in 1998** majoring in **Systems Engineering (Environmental Management)**. His master's research was supported by a grant from the Ministry of Science, Technology and Environment Malaysia, focusing on developing an expert system for terrestrial vegetation management for Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). In **2003**, he earned his **Ph.D. in Systems Engineering** with a research focus on creating an expert system for **ecotourism** accreditation and rating for Peninsular Malaysia, emphasising safety, health, and environmental assurance.

Prof. Vik Nair's career has been characterised by notable scholarly achievements and leadership roles. He served as a **Professor** at the **School of Hospitality**, **Tourism**, **and Culinary Arts at Taylor's University**, **Malaysia**. During his tenure, he also assumed key roles such as Programme Leader for the Responsible Rural Tourism Network and Associate Research Fellow at the Centre for Research and Innovation in Tourism (CRiT). Additionally, he founded and directed the Centre for Research and Development at Taylor's University. After 19 years of dedicated service, he left Taylor's University in **2017** to take up the position of **Dean of Graduate Studies and Research**, as well as **Professor in Sustainable Tourism** at the **University of The Bahamas**. He further excelled in academia and recently embraced the prestigious role of President of **DISTED College in Penang**, **Malaysia**, the oldest and premier institution in Penang.

Prof. Vik Nair is renowned for his expertise in **Sustainable and Responsible Tourism**, **Rural Tourism**, **Ecotourism Management**, **Environmental Management**, **and Community-based Tourism**. His invaluable insights and knowledge have made him a sought-after keynote speaker at international conferences and esteemed guest lecturer worldwide.

With more than 350 publications to his credit, he was also given the privilege of writing a monthly column on hospitality and tourism issues in **Business Today**, a leading business magazine in Malaysia; **IMPAK**, the official bulletin of the Department of Environment, Malaysia; and a columnist on Responsible Tourism, in the national newspaper, **Nassau Guardian**, in The Bahamas. Prof. Vik Nair is recognised for his commitment to environmental stewardship and holds a certification as a **Licensed Environmental Auditor in Environmental Management Systems.** He remains actively involved in several professional bodies, including the **International Ecotourism Club** in Greece (ecoclub.com), where he plays a pivotal role. He is currently the President of the **Malaysia Ecotourism Association (MEA)**, the past President of the **Asia-Pacific Council for Hotel**, **Restaurant**, and Institutional Education (APacCHRIE), and past Secretary of the **Tourism Educators Association of Malaysia (TEAM)**.

In 2002, he won the Taylor's Chairman's Staff Excellence Award and President's Award for Academic Excellence, followed by Research Excellence in 2002, 2007 and 2013. He has won numerous Best Paper Award for tourism research in many conferences nationally and internationally. In addition, he has also won many gold, and bronze medal in tourism innovations exhibitions from 2012 to 2014 in Malaysia, UK and Germany in collaboration with Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS). In 2006 and 2009, he was accorded the Merit and Honorary Awards, respectively, for Academic Leadership and Accomplishment as the Outstanding Young Malaysian of the Year, organised by Junior Chambers International, for his contribution to the ecotourism industry of Malaysia.

In the same year, he was also awarded the National Outstanding Educator (College Category) in the Private Education Excellence Awards 2023.

For his research and consultancy work, in 2011, he added another feather in his cap when he was awarded the largest national research grant for social sciences worth RM9 million for a 5-year project (2011-2016) on responsible rural tourism management under the Ministry of Education's Long-Term Research Grant Scheme (LRGS). He completed his first consultation work with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in writing the Sustainable Development Goals country report for The Bahamas in December 2017. He was also engaged with the Tourism Development Corporation of The Bahamas in developing community-based tourism toolkit for the country, and the Ministry of Environment in The Bahamas in developing an ecotourism production centre for East Grand Bahama island that was devastated by the 2019 Hurricane Dorian.
